What is the DDRT?

The Due Diligence Reporting Template (DDRT) is an industry-standard framework developed by AIAG and major OEMs to address forced labor risks in automotive supply chains. It is designed to help OEMs and suppliers demonstrate compliance with forced labor legislation, including the UFLPA in the U.S., as well as other ESG and emerging global regulations.

Purpose

Create one consistent reporting format accepted by all OEMs.

Scope

Tier 1 suppliers must report on their own Tier 1 suppliers (effectively their OEM customers' Tier 2).

Requirement

Tier 1 suppliers must begin submitting DDRTs in September 2025, with wider adoption expected in 2026.

Limitation

Predictive or Al-only data is not accepted. OEMs require supplier-led reporting supported by defensible evidence.

The barriers suppliers must overcome

Limited visibility



Supply chains extend far beyond direct Tier 1 suppliers, but most companies lack tools or cooperation to uncover deeper-tier relationships. Without this visibility, forced labor risks remain hidden.

Weak evidence



Al predictions or unverified claims are not accepted in DDRT submissions. Both OEMs and regulators expect defensible, supplier-led disclosures backed by trusted data sources.

Manual burden 🔀



Suppliers often receive information in different formats, then face the added challenge of submitting that data to multiple OEMs in yet more formats.
